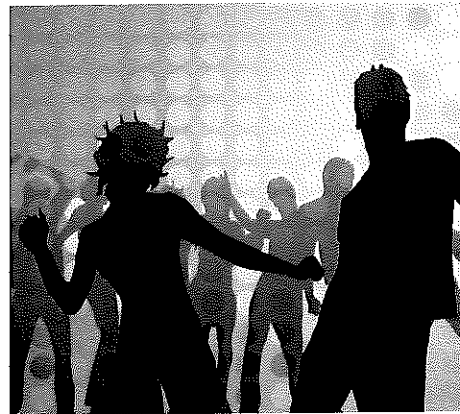


E Mediation and communication
